WHY IS STORYTELLING IMPORTANT?

Storytelling acts as fuel for the fire of literacy in a child's development. Hearing a story they love can inspire interest in learning more about a given topic. Stories tend to be addictive in the best way possible and can encourage children to read more stories and write them, too.

It is very important to start reading stories at an early age because through them children can learn a lot about the way life works around them.

On the one hand, they see a dramatic representation of problems, how characters choose to solve them and the positive and negative consequences of those choices. They meet characters from their own culture and others, and become familiar with a range of customs, personalities and points of view. The stories of others can help children deal with their own life experiences.

On the other hand, through stories children can learn a foreign language since they can know new vocabulary and expressions.

Furthermore, Storytelling provides children with the opportunity to practice social skills such as listening, making eye contact and taking turns, which are essential at these ages.

For these reasons, one of the tools used in our English lessons with children is storytelling. For instance, one day we read a story entitled "Betty the blue bug"; children aged 3 met in a room and they heard the story. They knew vocabulary about animals and colours. After that, children decorated the main character, a bug, with different colours and techniques.

It was a pleasant day and the children had lots of fun.






JOLLY Phonics

treasure!!















BOOK FAIR

MOBILE PHONES APPS

The students of 3º B ESO have worked on the invention of a new app for our mobile phones. These are some of them:

APP "THE MAGIC KEY"

It's an app for all mobile phones. You can download it from your Play Store. It costs 2.30 pounds/month.

With this app you will never lose your keys!

For security, you have to take a photo of the keys; the camera scans the key structure and saves it.

You must choose a keystone for each key that you have saved in the app.

If you lose your key, you will touch your screen and the photo of the key will be projected on it. Then, you will have to place the mobile phone at the door and the lock will open the door immediately.

If you don't pay the quota, the app will erase your keys photos.

You mustn't save more than 5 keys.

The app doesn't scan keys longer than 12 centimetres.

The app also works with the internet.

You should receive an e-mail with all the details before using it.

You mustn't download this app from another place, because others are false apps.

SCRATCHAPP

















ORIGINAL VERSIONS

Summer is getting close and we're sure that you want to improve your English while enjoying your holidays. We have some advice to improve your English without much effort and at the same time that you have fun. How?? Keep reading!

This important tip has to do with watching films and series in their original version. You can look for old DVDs at home, use your TV or watch them online. Initially, you can use subtitles (much better if they are in English) and then, watch them without subtitles. Of course, you can watch them without subtitles from the very beginning. At first, it will be a bit hard, but after a while you won't even notice it!

You can start with films or episodes that you have already watched. Your favourite movies will be easier for you to understand because you may have watched them over and over again. It is much more interesting than watching them dubbed, because you can enjoy the actors' full performance.

This is a great way of improving your English. You can learn a lot of vocabulary, revise structures and improve your listening skills. Don't forget that depending on its origin, the film will have a British or an American accent. Besides, you will be able to distinguish many different accents in the same film or TV series.


For the little ones, we highly recommend *Peppa Pig* series and its perfect RP English pronunciation or *Alphablocks*, which works with phonetics (you can find them on Youtube). Any cartoons they like and are available on TV or online may work. However, if they are too difficult or they are not familiar with them, it may be too hard and discouraging.



Older kids and teenagers can also benefit from watching their favourite TV series in the original version. No doubt any Disney film can be helpful since children watch them once and again. *Harry Potter* is another good choice for kids who have already watched the saga. As regards teenagers, TV series are always a good idea: *Big Bang Theory, Friends* or *Sherlock* are great options if you want to have a wonderful time and improve your English during the hot and long summer days. And if you prefer to enjoy English at the cinema, in Aragonia you can watch them with English subtitles and cheaper than other films!
